Cookstoves to prevent desertification

Many regions in Burkina Faso are suffering from desertification, soil degradation and more frequent droughts. The high demand of firewood leads the region into more severe forms of desertification.

This project promotes the distribution and utilisation of the mud made efficient woodstove "F3PA" (Foyer Trois Pierres Améliorés) in the province of Passoré, located in the North region of Burkina Faso. It replaces the traditional stove whilst respecting the local three stone cooking culture as these three stones are integrated inside its design.
